MINTHIS GOLF CLUB - LOCAL RULES

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 18.2)
Out-of-bounds is defined by the line between the course-side points at ground level of white stakes. Out-of-bounds is also defined by boundary walls, fences, and hedges.
2. PENALTY AREAS (RULE 17)
Penalty areas are defined by Red/Yellow stakes or Red/Yellow lines. The extents of concrete penalty areas are defined by the walls/concrete, the extents of all other penalty areas are defined by the line of Red/Yellow stakes. 2b) On holes 10 & 15 there has been a drop zone provided to give an extra relief option. 2c) If a ball lands on the 15th Green and then goes into the water another ball may be dropped back in line with the flag where it crossed the penalty area, dropped in the designated drop zone or played from the original position all under penalty of 1 stroke. It is not permitted to drop a ball on the green or immediate surround. Rule 17.1d (1)&(2).
3. NO PLAY ZONES
A no play zone is an area marked with Blue/Yellow/Red stakes with green tops and is a defined part of an abnormal course condition or a penalty area where play is not allowed and entry to this area is prohibited. An area defined by Blue Stakes with green tops is a no play zone and free relief must be taken from interference by the no play zone under rule 16.1f. An area defined by Red/Yellow stakes with green tops is a no play zone penalty area. When the ball is in the no play zone within the penalty area the ball must not be played as it lies, and relief must be taken from interference by the no play zone under Rule 17.1e.
4. IRRIGATION LAKE HOLES 9 AND 18 (RULE 17)
If a ball comes to rest within the no play zone penalty area between holes 9 and 18 the ball must not be played, and relief must be taken under the penalty of one stroke (rule 17.1). Entry to this area is prohibited.
5. GROUND UNDER REPAIR
Ground under repair is defined by any area encircled by a white line, blue stake and/or G.U.R sign.

6. ABNORMAL GROUND CONDITIONS INCLUDING IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (RULE 16)
5a) all concrete/artificially surfaced paths and adjacent edges
5b) Course furniture, including signs, ball washers and bells
5c) Halfway house/toilet
5d) Obstructions on a player's line of play that are within 2 club lengths of a putting green, and also within 2 club lengths of the ball.
5e) Staked trees and trees with stakes adjacent
5f) Erosional damage in bunkers caused by running water washouts
5g) Irrigation/drainage pipes and covers
7. INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE
All non-artificial surfaces access roads and paths i.e., gravel, stoned or hard core.
8. TEMPORARY LOCAL RULES
Please check the notice board for any temporary local rules.
9. EVACUATION PROCEDURE
An immediate suspension of play for a dangerous situation will be signaled by one prolonged note from an air horn. All other suspensions will be signaled by three consecutive notes from an air horn. In either case, resumption of play will be signaled by two consecutive notes from an air horn. See Rule 5.7b.
10. ETIQUETTE
As a matter of safety please always have regard for your fellow players and Minthis staff. As a courtesy, please repair ball marks, replace divots and rake bunkers
11. PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES
Math play – Loss of hole
Stroke play – General Penalty – 2 shots
- Pace of Play
Players should play their ball as soon as it is safe and considerate to do so – no 'honour' except in Match-play. Please follow "Ready Golf" guidelines whenever possible.
- Distances
Scorecard – Meters to the CENTRE of the green
Colored discs on the course – Meters to the CENTRE of the green
White disc – 200m Yellow disc – 150m Red disc – 100m
