MINTHIS GOLF CLUB - LOCAL RULES

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 2.1)

Beyond any wall, fence, hedge or line of white stakes/fence bounding the course

2. PENALTY AREAS (RULE 17)

- 2a) Yellow penalty areas are defined by yellow stake.
- 2b) Red penalty areas are defined by red stakes or redline
- 2c) The extent of the concrete penalty areas are defined by the walls/concrete, the extent of all other penalty areas are defined by the line of yellow or red stakes

3. ABNORMAL GROUND CONDITIONS (RULE 16)

- 3a) All concrete/ artificially surfaced paths and adjacent edges.
- 3b) Course furniture, including signs, ball washers and bells
- 3c) Halfway House/toilets
- 3d) Obstructions on a player's line of play, that are within 2 club lengths of a putting green, and also within 2 club lengths of the ball
- 3e) Staked trees and trees with stakes adjacent
- 3f) Erosional damage in bunkers caused by running water washouts.
- 3g) Irrigation/drainage pipes and covers

4. ISLAND GREEN

A ball coming to rest on the stones, water lining (but not the wall) or entering the water surrounding the green must be with a penalty of one stroke be a) Dropped in the designated drop zone or b) On the teeing ground - the ball to be played must be played from within the teeing ground. It may be played from anywhere within the teeing ground and may be teed c) Through the green - The ball to be played must be dropped and when it is dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green.

5. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES (DMD)

A player may obtain information by use of a DMD. If during a stipulated round a player uses a DMD to gauge or measure other conditions

that might affect their play (eg elevation changes, wind speed etc) the player is in breach of Rule 4.3a

A multi-functional device, such as a smartphone or PDA, may be used as a DMD, but it must not be used to gauge or measure other conditions where doing so would be a breach of Rule 4.3a

6. INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE

All non artificial surfaced access roads and paths i.e. gravel, stoned or hard core

7. TEMPORARY LOCAL RULES

Please check the notice board for any temporary local rules.

8. ETIQUETTE

Please have regard for the wellbeing of your fellow players and green keeping staff with regards to safety

9. PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES

Match play - Loss of hole
Stroke Play- General penalty - 2 shots

Pace of Play

Players should play their ball as soon as safe and considerate to do so- no 'Honour' except in Matchplay

Distances

Scorecard - Meters to the CENTRE of the green.
Distance posts/discs - Meters to the Centre of the green
